Dr Christopher Vickers graduated from Sydney University in 1979 with First Class Honours as a student of Royal North Shore Hospital. He completed his residency and specialist training in Gastroenterology at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital.

Christopher was the first Gastroenterologist to look after Liver Transplant patients in Australia in 1986, being involved with the first six transplant patients. He then went to the UK for several years to study liver diseases and organ transplantation.

When he returned to Australia, Christopher was appointed as a Specialist at St Vincent's Hospital where he still works. He has been a Consultant Gastroenterologist at Warringah Day Surgery since 1990 where he performs the following procedures:

- Colonoscopy
- Gastroscopy
- Oesophageal dilatation
- Haemorrhoid banding
- ERCP (Endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatography)
- Bilary and pancreatic stenting
- Removal of bile duct stones

Dr Vickers is a Fellow of the American Gastroenterology Association and a Fellow of the American Association for Liver Disease, awarded for scientific contributions in the fields of Gastroenterology and Liver Diseases. He teaches students of the University of New South Wales and the University of Notre Dame.
